



## **Summary of Terms for Content Reserve Network Suppliers**

1. An internet-based account with private login ID and password is provided to you, the publisher, and is self-administered. You have access to view real-time sales activity, upload content, metadata and indicate on sale date and geographic rights for your titles. You set the Suggested Retail Price (SRP) for each of your titles; we require a minimum of \$1.00 USD (or the equivalent in other currencies). You will establish terms for a wholesale discount (customarily 50% or greater). The SRP of each title less this discount will be paid to you for each title sold.
2. You determine the copyright protection settings (Digital Rights Management or DRM) and restrictions for each product. The DRM options are based upon the software format and the options provided by our technology partners (Microsoft, Adobe, Mobipocket, etc.) within the DRM server-side software.
3. Quarterly fees are based on the quantity level of unique digital titles, regardless of number of file formats, inventoried at the start of each quarter. For any publisher not authorizing sales to Content Reserve's library clients, a surcharge will be levied on the quarterly fees.

\* To be clear, the number of 'unique titles' is based on the number of titles in your account. The number of formats per titles is not considered in this calculation (e.g. title "XYZ" in PDF and LIT formats counts as 1 unique title).
